

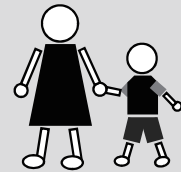
Fukuoka City Museum Rules



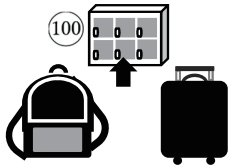
Leave umbrellas outside. Please put them in the umbrella stand at the entrance.



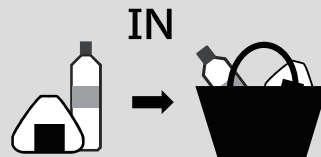
Do not eat or drink outside of designated areas.



Walk slowly in the museum.
Do not run.



Please leave large bags and items in coin lockers.
A 100 Yen coin is required to use the coin lockers. Money used for the coin locker will be returned after use.



Please keep food and drinks in your bag.

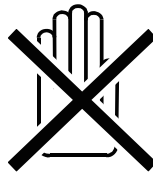


Request to school teachers

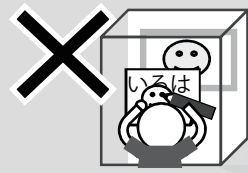
When you visit to Fukuoka City Museum for a field trip, please deposit children's bags and water bottles on the dedicated school shelf or leave these items on the bus.

Do not touch the exhibits and display cases.



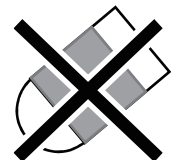
Do not write on the walls or display cases.



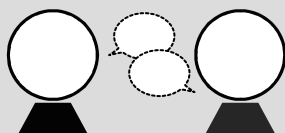
Do not kick the walls.

Speak softly.
Please refrain from speaking in a loud voice.

Requests to tour group leaders / tour organizers

- Please make sure that all visitors are aware of the Museum Rules and ask them to observe them when they visit the museum. Please provide guidance to your group appropriately.
- The museum does not use the PA system for tour group announcements. Please decide on a meeting time and place in advance before entering the museum.
- Please be considerate of other visitors when using notebooks and pencils in the museum.
- If you need a room for rest during the tour, such as if someone is sick, please ask a staff member. The museum cannot provide medical assistance.
- Eating and drinking is permitted in the open terrace, and the upstairs seating area (there is a space to consume your own food and beverages). Please be considerate of others when these areas are crowded.
- Please take your garbage with you.
