A Tiger doll created using the Hariko method was used as a gift to celebrate children's day. Wearing Hariko festive mask is the must to participate in the Hakata Dontaku festival. This exhibition introduces everything about the Hariko Papier-mâché method which originated in Hakata.   |
|                | Hakata in the Warring States<br>Period                                       | Jul. 14, 2020 (Tue.)~<br>Sep.13, 2020 (Sun.) | The 1550s was the period when drastic change occurred in the Kyushu area during the Sengoku (warring states) period. It was when the dualized political system, along with the conflict between the Ouchi and the Otomo families, collapsed. Numerous wars and hostilities were waged in the process of establishing the new political system. This exhibition explains this turbulent time in history through ancient writings.   |
